Your pet will most likely already have a microchip. As the UK's largest pet reunification service with over 3 million records on the database we recommend that you subscribe to Petlog Plus. Petlog reunification service is on hand 24 hours a day to authorised bodies such as dog wardens or animal welfare centres, who scan the animal's microchip and trace their owners via the Petlog database. A guide to help you complete the Registration of an Imported Dog

The owner who wishes to register an Imported Dog should complete this form. It should be completed in **BLOCK CAPITALS** in **black ink** throughout and sent to the Kennel Club.

(1) The Owner(s) name and address

The Applicant is the person importing the dog/bitch. Please complete all contact details here.

Imported dogs can only be registered to the same ownership as shown on the export pedigree or registration certificate received.

Declaration

The declaration must be signed by the applicant(s) in order for the Import form to be accepted.

(2) Dog Details

Please complete all sections in order for the Registration of an Imported Dog form to be accepted. The Kennel Club recognised name for the breed should be included in this section.

Imported dogs will normally only be accepted for those breeds recognised by the Kennel Club, but applications for importing other established foreign breeds will be considered by the General Committee. (see Notes i.)

The name of a dog imported from, and already registered in another country, cannot be changed except by the addition of an owner's Kennel Name/Affix, which can be incorporated free of charge at registration. It is permitted to use any one of the following joining words: – of, at, with, to, among, by, from, in, through, via, between, von, vom, del, for, under, over, cum, mit, avec.

Authority to Compete (ATC)

Dogs already recorded with an Authority to Compete Number, which become resident in the UK, may be registered onto the breed register, using this form. The dog must be transferred with the overseas Kennel Club into the name of the person importing the dog. An export pedigree (if applicable) or a registration certificate must accompany this form. Photocopies of the original documents will be accepted.

(3) The Breeder(s) name and address

The Breeder is the person who bred the dog/bitch. Please complete all contact details here.

(4) Fee and Additional Items

There are additional services available with your application to Register an Imported Dog form. Please indicate here which items you require including the initial application fee.

Please include the Kennel Name/Affix in the space provided to receive the Kennel Gazette subscription for £13.

Glossary of Canine Terms

Dam	<i>Mother of the litter</i>
Sire/Stud Dog	<i>Father of the litter</i>
Whelping	<i>Date puppies born</i>
Breeder	<i>Registered owner of the dam</i>
Progeny	<i>Offspring/puppies</i>
Kennel Name/Affix	<i>Name exclusive to breeder</i>

NOTES:

- i. The Kennel Club will normally only accept registration for dogs from overseas countries where the Kennel Club has a reciprocal agreement with the overseas Kennel Club which have full membership, associate membership or contract partnership of the FCI. Application for the registration of a dog imported from other countries may be considered by the Committee. Application must be made **BEFORE** the dog is imported.
- ii. All imported dogs will have the letters "IMP" and a 3 letter country code to show its origin added to their Kennel Club registered name.
- iii. Bitches imported in whelp should be registered with the Kennel Club if the bitch is remaining in the UK. Bitches imported should use this form accompanied by the relevant documentation – 3 or 5 generation export pedigree and owner registration certificate (if applicable). The litter may then be registered on a Form 1 accompanied by a certified 3 or 5 generation pedigree issued by the country or origin for the Sire.
- iv. If the bitch is returned to the country of origin without leaving quarantine after whelping, then it does not require to be registered with the Kennel Club. The Litter Registration Form should be accompanied by certified 3 generation pedigrees of both the Dam and Sire from the country of origin.
- v. A Kennel Club registered dog, originally exported from the UK, should be re-registered when it returns to the UK. A Re-Importation of a Dog/Bitch form (Form 17) should be completed.

Quarantine

- i. Applications to register imported dogs may be submitted whilst the dog is still in quarantine, although registration itself will not take place until the dog has left quarantine.
- ii. Dogs entering the country either under the existing Quarantine Regulations of the Traded Dogs Regulations (Balai Directive) or the Pets Passport Scheme, must do so strictly in accordance with DEFRA Regulations. The required documentation should be retained by the person importing the dog, and must be available if requested.

Check List

- Have you completed all sections required?
- Have you included a copy of the export pedigree certificate?
- Have you checked all parties have signed the declaration?
- Have you included a copy of the owner registration certificate? (if applicable)
- Have you included your payment?
